#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The International Office of the home university must submit the official nomination of the student via email to: incomingpuce@puce.edu.ec

Applications that have not been nominated will not be considered.

The email must include the following information:

- Student's full names and surnames
- Identity document or passport number
- Degree program and current semester/year at the home university
- Degree program the student will enroll in at PUCE
- Student's email address and phone contact

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Once nominated, the student must complete the following registration form (Link) and upload the documents listed below:

- 1. Color copy of the passport.
- 2. Passport-sized photograph.
- 3. Registration form.
- 4. Academic transcript issued by the home university.
- 5. Spanish B1.2 B2 certification (if applicable).
- 6.Official nomination letter issued by the university.
- 7. Statement of purpose explaining the motivations for studying at PUCE.
- 8. Health certificate.
- 9. Health and life insurance with international coverage.

#### **DOCUMENTS FOR THE VISA**

#### **Granting of Temporary Residence Visa for Students**

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- All documents in a language other than Spanish must be translated and notarized.
- ★ Valid passport with at least 6 months of validity.
- Migration movement document issued by the relevant authorities.
- Triminal record certificate from the country of origin or from any country where the applicant has resided in the last five years.
- Proof of sufficient financial means to support oneself in Ecuador.
- For students whose nationality allows them to enter Ecuador without a visa and who have not been able to obtain a temporary student resident visa, they must apply for an extension of their stay according to the period granted by migration authorities upon entry into Ecuador.
